

Lockport District 91 2007-2008 District Goals

- 1. Institute an annual review of data pertaining to student and staff safety within the schools and update school & district safety plans accordingly.**
 - a. Each spring the building principals will review with the Board of Education student discipline data.
 - b. Building Safety Plans will be evaluated each year and updated as necessary.

- 2. The District Building & Grounds will be attended to in a systematic and financially responsible manner.**
 - a. Focus will be on implementing and executing a life safety and building infrastructure improvement project.
 - b. Finances will be allocated as possible to address building infrastructure and maintenance needs.

- 3. Student Achievement will continue to be evaluated, with the Board of Education kept informed of student progress and areas of needs.**
 - a. Academic performance will continue to be tracked and evaluated. This will include all student sub-groups (special education, low-income, etc). The Board of Education will be updated on student academic performance including internal (classroom) and external (ISAT/CAT) measures.
 - b. AYP will be tracked, evaluated and shared with the Board of education each fall.

- 4. The Character Counts!, Pursing Victory with Honor, and PBIS Programs will continued to be implements and evaluated throughout the District grade levels and athletic programs.**
 - a. Staff and administration will attend training pertaining to these programs as needed.
 - b. Parents and community members will be kept updated on the goals and expectations of these programs.
 - c. Data will be shared with the Board of Education annually.

- 5. The District will continue to focus on communicating with and providing opportunities to the community at large to be involved with the District schools.**
 - a. Develop and streamline possible means of communication.
 - b. Develop comprehensive media/marketing plan.
 - c. Provide opportunities for the community to become involved in the schools.

- 6. The District will continue to evaluate and share the financial progress of the District with the community.**

- 7. Professional Development Opportunities will continue to be encouraged and provided to staff.**
 - a. Staff will be informed of professional development opportunities available.

- b. Staff participation in staff development will be tracked and shared with the Board of education.
- c. Administration will develop a professional development opportunity plan for the District.
- d. Grants will continue to be pursued to address the financial cost associated with professional development.

The Board of Education recognizes that these goals are on-going and nature and may require more than one year to achieve.
