The committee members reviewed the work completed over the winter break. The additional security cameras for both buildings have been mounted but still need to be wired. Mrs. Slingerland questioned the sandblasting of the 5th grade bathroom partitions, stating it warped the partitions and doors. Mr. Pierson stated this work had been contracted out and that he would check with the company to see if they could address the concerns.

Parking lot lighting was discussed for Milne Grove. Ms. Murray indicated that the lack of lighting is a concern to teachers at Milne Grove.

Dan Brandalino from Chevron, presented information to the committee pertaining to health life safety and building infrastructure upgrades that his company could provide the school.

Mr. Pierson distributed a Strategic Plan for addressing building needs. He indicated that this is a “working document” and would be adjusted as finances/resources become available and priorities are determined by the committee.
