



Lockport Elementary School District 91 2010-2011 District Goals

1. The District will continue to focus on and modify its Response to Intervention (RTI) plan at both buildings.
 - a. Building staff will continue to be trained in RTI.
 - b. An RTI Coach will be hired through LASEC ; each of the five member districts will utilize one day per week with the RTI coach.
 - c. Parents will be provided information throughout the year about RTI goals, expectations, and accomplishments.
 - d. Data will be shared with the Board of Education annually.
2. The District will continue to focus on communicating with and providing opportunities for parents and community members to be involved with the District schools.
 - a. The District Advisory Committee will research communication strategies currently used in the District and make recommendations regarding future communication efforts. Data will be formally presented to the Board of Education to consider prior to implementation of changes.
 - b. Parent/Community Coffees will continue to be scheduled for the 2010-2011 school year at both schools.
3. The District will continue to evaluate and share the financial progress of the District with the community.
 - a. The Board of Education will develop several programming scenarios to address state funding concerns.
4. The District will focus on differentiated instruction in order to provide instructional delivery methods that meet the needs of ALL students.
 - a. The District will continue its partnership with the University of St. Francis and consultant, Amy Brodeur, for the 2010-2011 school term contingent on grant funds remaining available.

The Board of Education recognizes that these goals are on-going in nature and may require more than one year to achieve.
