Remind your child about the things we discussed in the library about staying safe online:

- Always use a computer where an adult can watch you, never in a closed room.
- Check new websites with an adult BEFORE trying them yourself.
- NEVER give out personal information through the computer!
- If anyone asks you for personal information through the computer, tell an adult right away!
- NEVER arrange to meet anyone who you meet through the computer. Never meet anyone new without your parents!
- If you see something inappropriate on your computer, turn off the monitor and get an adult.
- Don't say or type mean or untrue things about others.
