What Looks the Same?

Here are some of the mitigations that will remain in place from last year:

- **UNIVERSAL MASKING**
- The use of PE locker rooms will continue to be suspended until further notice
- Internal traffic patterns (hallway patterns, social distancing while waiting in line, etc.)
- Students will have their own supply boxes
- Classrooms will be set up to encourage social distancing at the furthest possible distance (minimum of 3 feet) while maintaining the integrity of the learning atmosphere
- Students will be kept within a cohort in classrooms and lunch at both MG and KG
- Students will be spaced 6 feet apart while eating lunch at MG
- Classrooms will be disinfected every evening using a static sprayer
- Classrooms will be equipped with sanitization stations and PPE
- PE will be in the gymnasium
- COVID tracking will continue
- COVID testing when applicable (BinaxNOW)
- Quarantine period will follow IDPH guidelines
- Masks will be worn on all special education and athletic transportation
- Maintain indoor air quality per CDC/IDPH guidance to the greatest extent possible

What Looks Different?

Here are some of the changes you will see:

- No more daily temperature checks at the door (checked on as needed basis)
- No more daily health symptom certification; both staff and students will sign-off at start of the year that by entering the building they are self certifying they are symptom free
- Desk and Privacy shields may be used on a case by case situation. Shields will remain in place in the building public offices.
- The use of hallway lockers/cubbies/coat hooks will be used by students to store personal belongings
- Shared books (library, guided reading, etc.) will not be quarantined for 72 hours
- Quarantine students will receive work and have access to their teacher during designated times in the day; no live stream instruction will be provided
- The Lockport Township Park District plans to hold the OASIS program in both Milne Grove and Kelvin Grove for the 2021-2022 school year.
- All after school activities and athletics will be offered throughout the 2021-2022 school year when appropriate.

Here are some of the changes you will see (continued):

- School hours will be 8:30am-3:10pm every day.
- Class times will occur on a consistent schedule throughout the week as appropriate for each grade level (full five-day a week in-person instruction).
- Students will travel to assigned classrooms throughout the day (i.e. jr high core, PE, etc.)
- Students will be spaced 5-6 feet apart while eating lunch at KG
- Fewer lunch times at KG to allow for 20 more instructional minutes per day in both ELA and Math
- Updated drop-off/dismissal procedures at KG & MG to use fewer building entrances/exits
- Students will participate in specials/exploratory classes each day in the designated classroom.
- K-8 students will receive instruction provided by their assigned schedule and will rotate between classrooms to their assigned content area teachers who will provide instruction.

Here are some of the changes you will see (continued):

- Quarantine Identification:
 - If vaccinated - will not be quarantined (unless symptomatic)
 - If not vaccinated - will NOT be quarantined IF both students are masked and seated 3 feet or more away from COVID positive person (not considered close contact)
 - If not vaccinated - will be quarantined if no mask is worn by COVID positive student and/or any student and within 3-6 feet of student for 15 minutes or more
- Quarantine instruction:
 - No live stream instruction
 - May be provided using Google Apps for Education based on the student's current classroom schedule.
 - Treated similar to a sick day - student's receive work from their teacher to complete
 - Students may check in with someone other than the assigned classroom teacher(s).
