### Lockport Township F.I.S.H. Food Pantry

Located in the Township Building at 1463 S. Farrell Road, the food pantry is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:30am - 11:30am to residents.

Requirements for the FISH Food Pantry:

- One of the staff volunteers of the FISH Food Pantry will conduct a small interview to determine what exactly they can do to help.
- To qualify for food pantry benefits residents must provide two types of proof of residency living in Lockport Township. The easiest proof would be a current electric, gas, or water bill. A driver's license is not proof of residency. After being accepted residents are able to visit the food pantry once a month.
