

# Grade Level Data: Attendance & Grades







### Week 1: Students w/ at least one absence



## Midterm: 8/24-10/7/20




### D's & F's by Grade Level : Total 182 F's/33 D's

## **Re-Implementation of Tutoring Program**


- Content areas of ELA and Math

- EXIT SLIP: Students must complete that exit slip by identifying one emotion from the emotion wheel and explaining why they chose that emotion. Additionally, what can the student do with the emotion?




#### Kelvin Grove Jr High School Dashboard Summary


