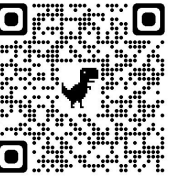

We use Chroma Key Technology

Chroma key is a technique where a block of a blue or green in a video image can be replaced either by another color or image. It enables – for example – a weather forecaster or broadcaster to appear against a background of a computer-generated weather map or news studio.

We use the DoInk app to produce our broadcasts.

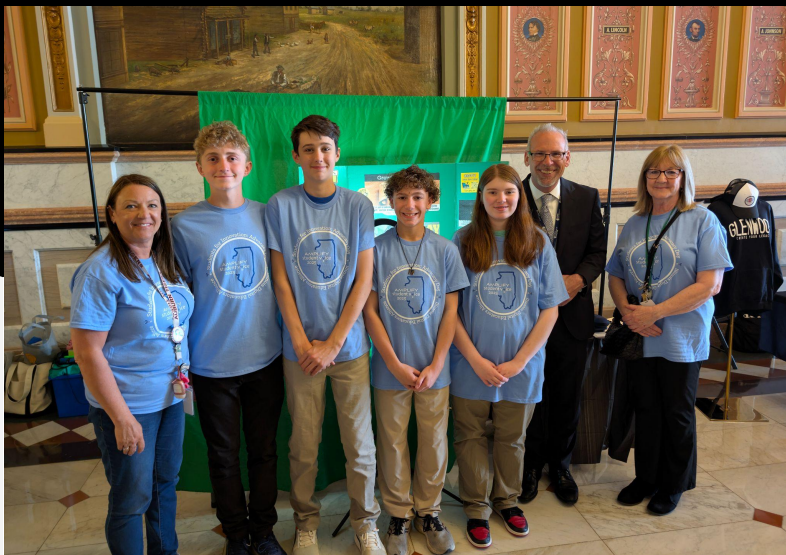
